HOBBIES EXHIBITION (was Handicraft & Art) (NON-COMPETITIVE)

HOB1. A display of your hobbies – please bring fixings, stands etc.

HOUSEHOLD – use your own recipe; please supply the recipe for others to enjoy and replicate. COMPETITIVE

- H1. Chocolate cake decorated.
- H2. Carrot cake
- H3. Cheese straws
- H4. One jar of soft fruit jam
- H5. One jar of chutney
- H6. Vegan loaf cake to include fruit or vegetables.
- H7. Swiss Roll

PHOTOGRAPHY Single black & white or colour_- visitors to vote for their favourite photo COMPETITIVE

- P1. A Beautiful Bloom
- P2. Flowers and/or wildlife in my/or the garden

NOVELTY COMPETITIVE

- N1 Heaviest red or white potato
- N2 Mini flower arrangement in an egg cup, shot glass or similar size.

FRUIT – SEASONAL – displayed on a paper plate **COMPETITIVE**.

F1. Display of one or more seasonal fruit on a paper plate (e.g. strawberries, raspberries, gooseberries etc.)

CHILDRENS CLASSES COMPETITIVE

Best in Class rosette awarded for First, Second and Third prize.

C1. Collage on paper plate of three different natural materials (e.g. petals, twigs, leaves etc.)





- C2. Painted picture of flower, plant, or tree
- C3. Garden in a seed tray





C4. A mug/jam jar of paper flowers (e.g. tissue paper, origami, quilling etc.)







VEGETABLES COMPETITIVE

- V1. Medley of own grown vegetables in a seed tray
- V2. 5 tomatoes
- V3. Longest runner bean
- V4. 5 potatoes red or white
- V5. 3 courgettes
- V6. A cucumber
- V7. 5 carrots
- V8. 3 beetroots
- V9. 3-5 Shallots/onions displayed in sand tray
- V10. Any other vegetable (e.g. pea, rhubarb, broad bean etc.)
- V11. An arrangement of herbs in a recycled container e.g. bean can, jam jar etc.

CUT FLOWERS - vase provided or use own COMPETITIVE

- CF1. 1 vase of sweet peas, maximum 7 stems
- CF2. 1 vase foliage
- CF3. 1 vase up to 5 stems of perennial flowers
- CF4. A vase of flowering Hydrangeas, 3 stems
- CF5. 1 vase of hardy Pinks, up to 7 stems
- CF6. 1 vase Dahlias, maximum 5 blooms
- CF7. 1 vase annual or perennial flowers, up to 7 stems

SHOWSTOPPER VASE COMPETITIVE

A vase of mixed flowering stems containing a total of between 5 and 10 stems taken from a minimum of 2 kinds of plants. Arranged for FRONTAL EFFECT. Vase is provided.

ROSES COMPETITIVE

- R1. 1 specimen Hybrid Tea rose any colour.
- R2. A vase of 3 blooms, any variety e.g., rambler, old fashioned shrub
- R3. 1 specimen Floribunda any colour
- R4 1 rose bloom floating in a bowl of water, bowl provided.

POT & CONTAINER PLANTS - INDOOR OR OUTDOOR (please bring own tray to sit pot on) COMPETITIVE.

- PC1. 1 flowering fuchsia best specimen for presentation
- PC2. Ornamental foliage fuchsia
- PC2. An arrangement of 1 or more cactus/succulent
- PC3. Flowering pot plant (e.g. orchid, begonia)
- PC4. Mixed pot/container of mixed planting
- PC5. Flower with own foliage, in a frame, frame provided.

FLORAL DECORATION COMPETITIVE Shop bought flowers allowed for FL2, FL3 and FL4.

Maximum size 600mm x 600mm

If possible, please use alternatives to floral foam (e.g., chicken wire, pin holders, Agra wool)

- FL1. Home grown flowers in an unusual container.
- FL2. All foliage arrangement
- FL3. Naturalistic arrangement
